**RECRUITMENT NOTICE**

Regional Institute of Ophthalmology, Kolkata will engage personnel for the position of **Counsellors** for the **Kolkata based Medical College & Hospitals of West Bengal** on **contract basis** in **National Program for Control of Blindness & Visual Impairment (NPCB&VI)** under **National Health Mission**. The applicant must be the permanent residence of **West Bengal**.

Eligible candidates should apply in the prescribed format as given in the Department's website ([www.wbhealth.gov.in](http://www.wbhealth.gov.in) and [www.riokolkata.in](http://www.riokolkata.in)) alongwith self-attested photocopies of all testimonials. Application for the mentioned position should reach on or before 4 PM of 15.03.2024 (Friday) for the above mentioned position. Application forms not properly filled in or incomplete application forms are liable to be cancelled.

Application fees`Rs. 50/- for Reserved category candidates (ST) have to be deposited through a bank draft in favour of Regional Institute of Ophthalmology payable at Service Branch, Kolkata. The amount is non-refundable. Any application received without the application fees will be treated as cancelled.

Fluency in Local languages both in writing and speaking (Bengali must be 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> language in the 10<sup>th</sup> standard or 12<sup>th</sup> standard.)

Desirable Qualification : Master Degree in Social Science from recognized institution.

Essential Post Qualification : Two years working experience in Health Sector/Social Sector.  
Experience.

Desirable Experience : Out of the essential two years' experience, completed one year experience in counselling services at health sector.

Process of engagement : Selection will be made on the basis of marks obtain in the academic qualification, experience and written test.

2. Atleast six month certificate course from the any govt. affiliated institution is required to be produce in support of the computer knowledge.
3. If proper signature and self-attested photograph are not attached at the time of application that application shall also be liable to be cancelled.
4. The Essential Qualifications mentioned are the minimum and mere possession of the same does not entitle the candidate to claim selection. **All the essential qualification must be completed on or before the date of publication of the advertisement.**
5. Experience will be calculated after obtaining the required essential qualification for the above mentioned position, till the date of publication of the recruitment notice.



6. The marks for experience will not be given without submission of proper experience certificate containing proper signature, stamp of the organization, designation, date of joining and date of leaving. The recruitment authority will ask for appointment order/letter / joining letter, if required.
7. **Caste Certificate issued on or before the date of publication of the recruitment notice, by the competent authorities of West Bengal only will be accepted.**
8. No **rounding off** of marks will be granted. Proportionate marking upto 2 decimal points will be considered.
9. The Bank draft must be issued on or after the publication of the recruitment notice in favour of Regional Institute of Ophthalmology payable at Service Branch, Kolkata. No other mode of deposition of application fees will be granted. Application received without requisite fees will not be considered at any circumstances. Application fees will not be refunded against the cancelled application.
10. Applicant must mention the name of the post, DOB, Name of the Candidate and caste category at the back of the bank draft.

Application containing a sealed envelope must be reached at the Office of the Regional Institute of Ophthalmology through **speed post only** within 4 PM of **15<sup>th</sup> of March'2024** (Friday) mentioning "Application for the post of ....." and "Category ....." in the top of the envelope. All the self-attested photocopies copy of ---(i) Photo id proof & address proof of the applicant, (ii) Proof of age, (iii) all the marksheets & pass certificate of educational qualifications, (iv) caste certificate (if any), (v) Six month certificate course on computer from any govt. affiliated institution and (vi) certificates related to the experience must be attached along with completely fill up and signed application format.
13. The candidates, if found ineligible after verification process, will not be called for the subsequent stages of the selection process.
